## InTouch Technologies Team

The executive team of InTouch Technologies possesses business, technical and clinical expertise across a broad range of medical products, services and applications, including computerized robotic surgical systems, telemedicine and tele-operated robotic systems, human-to-machine interfaces, speech recognition, computing systems architecture and operating systems, Web infrastructure, broadband and telecommunications. The team's fields of clinical application experience include long-term care, cardiovascular and cardiothoracic surgery, minimally invasive surgery, spine, neurology, urology, orthopedics, pediatrics and gynecology.

### **Yulun Wang, PhD** **Chairman & Chief Executive Officer**

In 1989, Dr. Wang founded Computer Motion, the company which pioneered surgical robotics. He was the principal architect and inventor of the voice-controlled robotic arm called AESOP, the 1st FDA-cleared surgical robot, as well as the ZEUS robotic surgical system, which performed the world's first transatlantic surgery. Computer Motion went public in 1997, and merged with Intuitive Surgical in 2003 for one third of the resulting company. In 2002, Dr. Wang founded InTouch Technologies (dba InTouch Health), a company which pioneers remote presence robot systems that enable healthcare professionals to provide more effective and efficient healthcare by allowing them to "be in two places at once".

In September 2000, the National Academy of Engineers selected Dr. Wang as one of the nation's top young engineers to participate in the Frontiers of Engineering program. Dr. Wang was further honored in June 2005 when Ernst & Young named him Finalist for their Entrepreneur of the Year award. He has more than 40 publications and 50 patents in the areas of robotics and computers. Frequently invited to speak at noteworthy meetings and events, he has appeared on the Today Show, CNN and various other televised interviews.

Dr. Wang has a Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering specializing in Robotics from the University of California at Santa Barbara.

**David J. Adornetto**  
**CFO and Executive Vice President of Operations**

David Adornetto has more than 20 years of healthcare industry and senior management experience. Mr. Adornetto was most recently Executive Vice President of Operations at Mentor Corporation where he oversaw manufacturing, new product development, and business development. Mr. Jordan's core expertise is in digital system design for robotic controls, but he also has extensive experience in software development and mechanism design.
